

Community Health Worker (CHW) Training Program Announcement

Center for the Study of Social Determinants of Health, Institute on Health Disparities, Equity and the Exposome, Meharry Medical College in collaboration with:

Baptist Health Sciences University, University of Tennessee Health Science Center, Rural Health Association of Tennessee, and community partners

Greetings! We are both expanding the HealthWorks CHW training and recruiting persons who want to participate. The expanded CHW training will consist of **four options: CHW 1 (HRSA/HealthWorks), CHW II (CVS), CHW III (HRSA CHW) and CHW IV (HRSA Apprenticeship).** All candidates must complete Option 1. Some may choose to complete 1 only; others will want to complete option 1 and 2 or 1, 2, and 3; while others will want to complete options 1, 2, 3, and 4. Option 1 will take less than one week to complete; Option 2 will take approximately four weeks to complete; Option 3 will take 13 weeks to complete; while Option 4 will take approximately 13 months to complete. All options are calculated based on a full-time basis of 7 hours per day. All options provide stipends during training @ \$15/hour.

Enrollment is now open. The first class of 15 will begin April 3, 2023 and is limited to persons who have completed Option 1 (see below). To enroll go to: website or contact Mr. Rafael Santiago at <u>rsantiago@mmc.edu</u>.

Eligibility criteria:

- US citizen
- 16 years and above (for CVS program only; for other programs minimum age is 18)
- English comprehension
- Enrollment/Time commitment

CHW Option One: HRSA/HealthWorks CHW (16 hours; two weeks to complete)

- Sign up for HealthWorks CHW workshops with R Santiago

Curriculum: 4 modules/16 hours

- Motivational Interviewing (8 hours) UTHSC
- COVID-19 modules (4 hours) MMC
- Community ethics in research (2 hours) MMC
- Health Information Technology (2 hours) MMC

Outcomes:

- Complete 16 hours didactic training
- Motivational Interviewing (UTHSC certificate of completion)
- 4 CEU credits (MMC / COVID-19)
- Certificate of completion for Community research ethics (VUMC/MMC CTSA)
- \$500 stipend (upon completion) (1JG)
- \$100 for participating in COVID 19 community vaccine events (1JG)

CHW Option Two: CVS CHW (142 hours; six weeks to complete)

- Identify training site (clinic or community agency)
