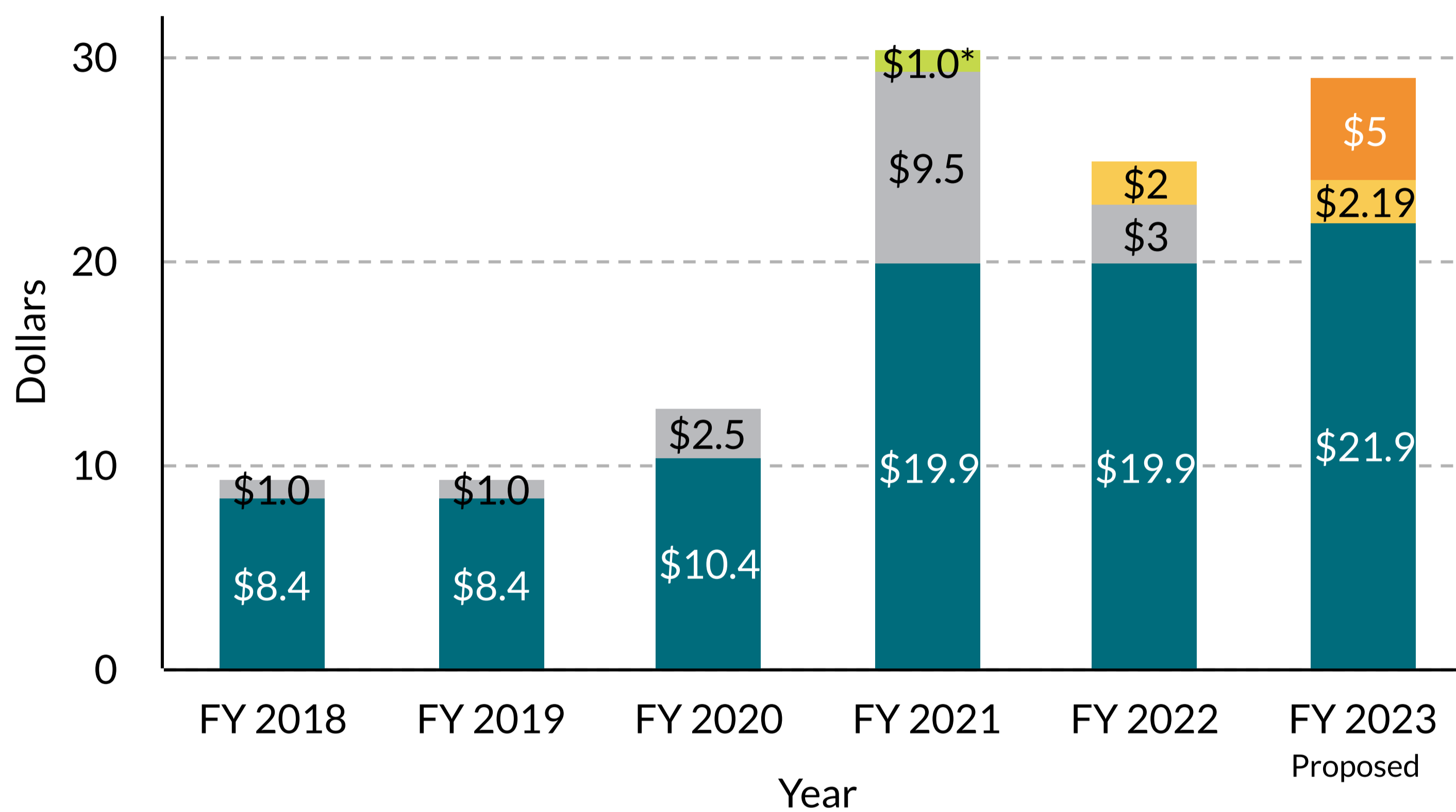
Your Support Continues to Increase Access to Quality Health Care for Uninsured and Underserved Tennesseans. Thank You!



Tennessee Charitable Care Network (TCCN) requests continued support to:

- ◆ Maintain consistent Safety Net Grant funding by **supporting the \$5 million supplemental appropriation amendment for FY 2021**. The Safety Net Grant program partially offsets the cost of providing free and charitable health care services (medical, dental, behavioral health, care coordination, and prescription medications) to low-income uninsured Tennesseans.
- ◆ Support the Governor's request for expanded dental services.

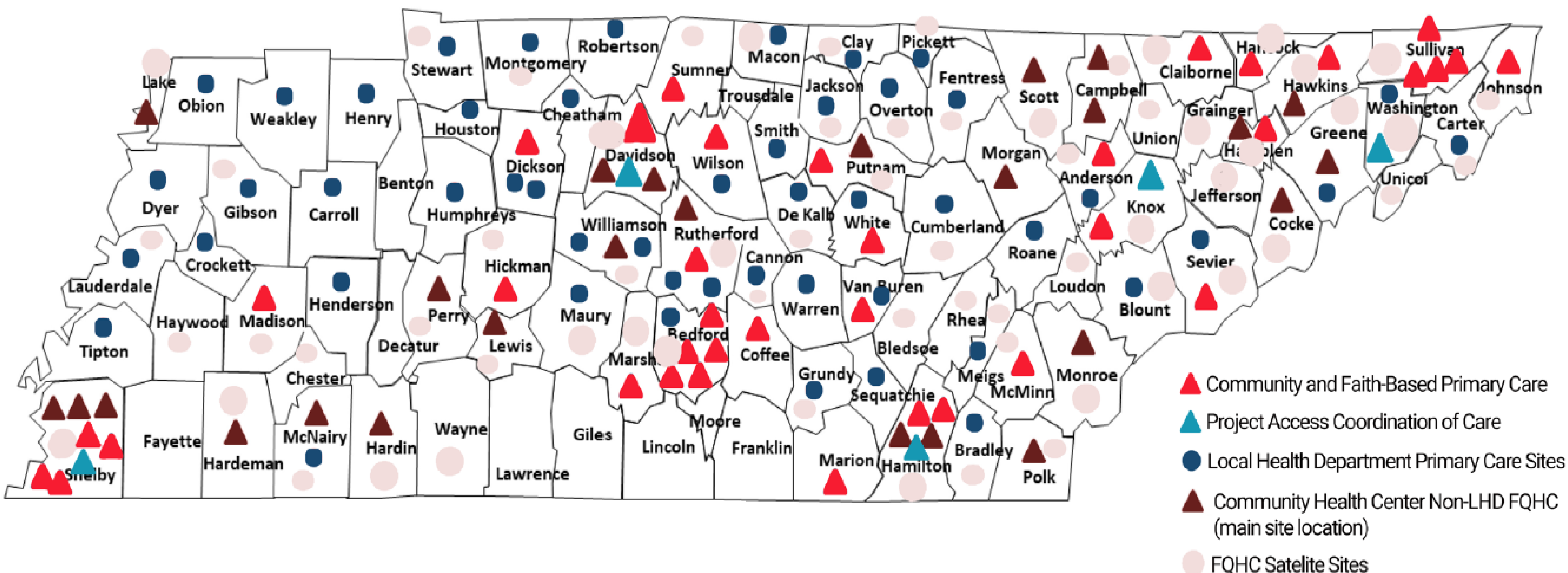
Health Care Safety Net Funding History

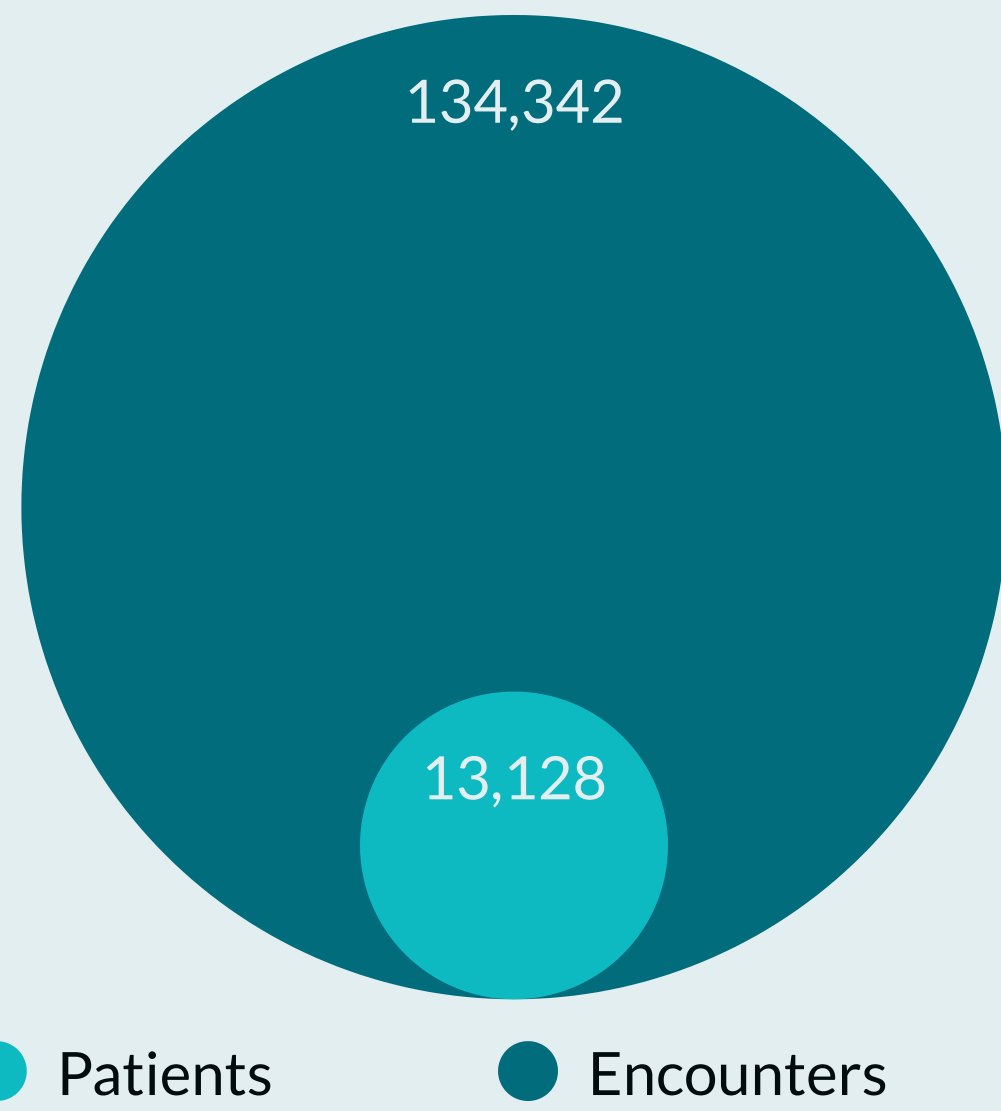
TDH-Funded Uninsured Adult Healthcare Safety Net Providers and Locations

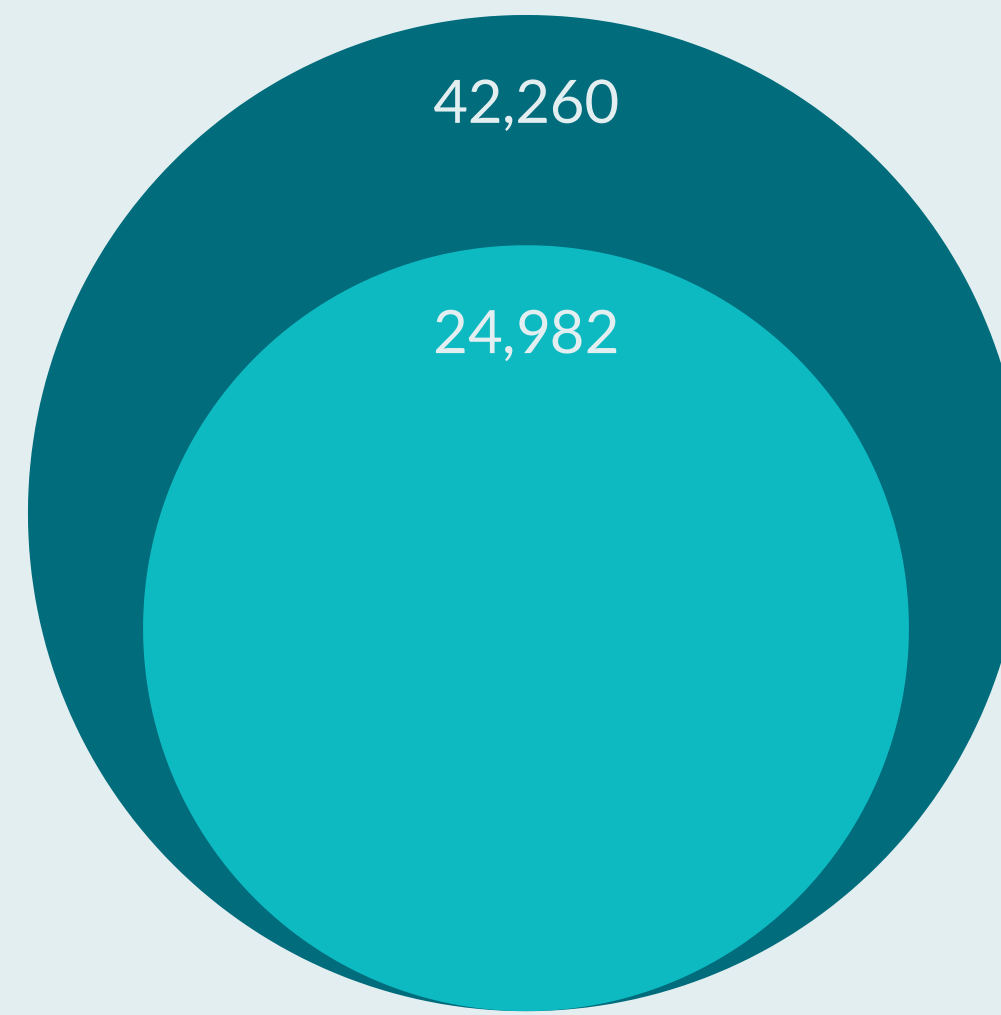
Specialty Care Coordination Encounters Provided by Project Access

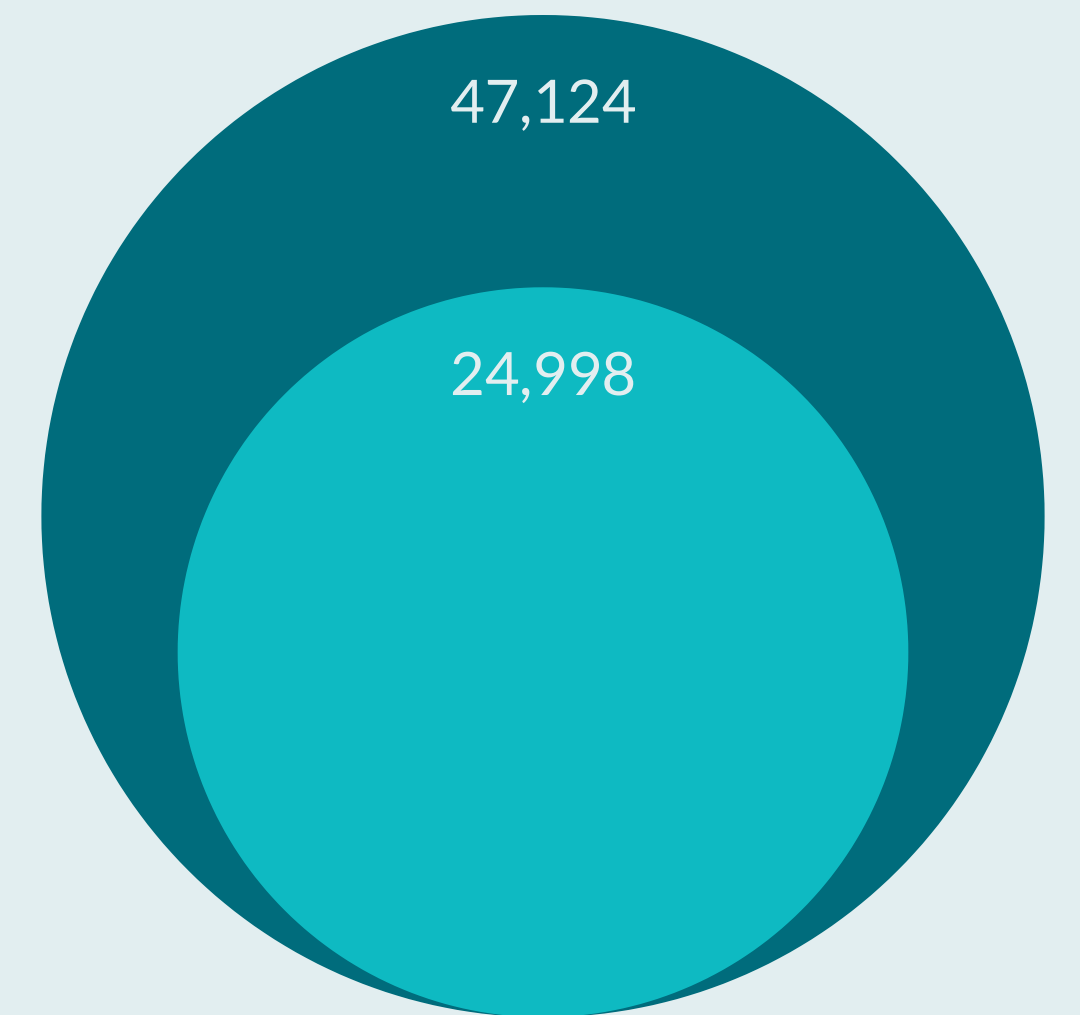

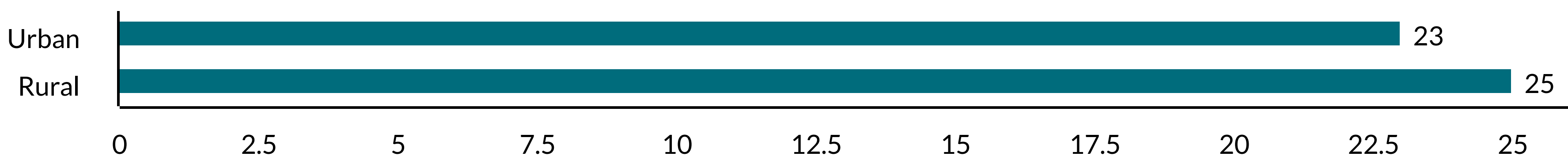
